



## **Position Title: Youth Ministry Intern**

**Position Description:** The Youth Ministry Intern will assist the Family Ministries Director in planning, coordinating, and leading programs to facilitate spiritual growth of the church's youth (Grades 6-12). This role aims to provide practical ministry experience, spiritual growth, and professional development opportunities in a supportive and learning-focused environment.

**Christ Presbyterian Church Vision and Values:** Christ Presbyterian Church envisions a world that is loving and inclusive. We unite with God to be a worshipping community without barriers, a sanctuary for all. We seek to follow Jesus by doing justice, loving mercy, and walking humbly with God. **Accountability and Relationships:** Serves under the direct supervision of the Family Ministries Director. Will interact regularly with the Pastors and Youth Ministry Council.

**Position Scope and Compensation:** \$18/hr, 8-10 hours/week, for a total of 350 hours, September 2024 - May 2025.

- Sundays 5:00-7:30pm weekly
- Sundays 8:45am-12:15pm twice a month
- One weekly meeting with supervisor
- One monthly meeting with Youth Ministry Commission
- Once a month service opportunity with youth
- Youth Retreat - full weekend in late winter or spring
- Possibility of additional hours Summer 2025, including Youth Mission Trip

### **Youth Ministry Intern Responsibilities**

- Build meaningful relationships with youth, providing mentorship and spiritual guidance.
- Engage with students and caregivers to foster a supportive and inclusive community.
- Provide an environment and ethos of active outreach, welcome and invitation to all youth, regardless of faith background and experience
- Be available to youth in a variety of ways (in person, in prayer, attending extra curricular activities, through social media and electronic communications, etc).
- Assist in the planning and execution of Sunday youth ministry, special events, retreats, and outreach activities.

- Assist in the development of small group discussions, Bible studies, and prayer sessions. Lead small group discussion, Bible studies, and prayer sessions.
- Assist with communication channels including social media, newsletters, and event promotion.

### **Qualifications**

- Spiritual maturity, social-emotional health, and a desire to learn and grow in faith
- Education and/or experience with Christian faith formation in a progressive church, as a participant, student or leader
- A commitment to the long-term health, vitality, and witness of the church
- Strong written/verbal communication skills
