



Position Description: Nursery Worker (part-time, 4-10 hours per week)

Purpose: Our Nursery Worker assists in creating an inclusive, safe, and welcoming place for our little ones. They will be a part of a team of nursery workers and volunteers, working in conjunction with the Director of Family Ministries and the other nursery staff. They will have the opportunity to utilize their gifts and develop their skills both in leadership and caregiving. Christ Presbyterian Church is a place that loves their children. Caregivers are a welcome part of our community. They have the fun of getting to know our children and families while they watch the children as they grow and change.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Provide care during Sunday morning services and seasonal mid-week services
- Nursery Workers are expected to work in the church nursery Sunday mornings 7:45am-11:45am
- Provide safe childcare for babies, toddlers, and preschool-aged children.
- Provide simple and playful structure for children in nursery including but not limited to open play time, story time with provided books, snack time, etc.
- Notify Dir. of Family Ministries when supplies need to be restocked.
- Connect with families as they drop off/pick up children and ensure a safe and easy transition during drop off/pick up
- Provide an organized and simple check-in/ out procedure for adult guardians.
- Ensures and participates in regular cleaning and sanitizing of nursery including sanitizing toys, play areas, etc after every shift in accordance with CPC COVID Policy.

Qualifications:

- Age 18 or older
- High school diploma, GED or equivalent
- Experience with childcare and family communication
- Understanding of the importance of and how to implement play-based learning
- Previous experience with in open and affirming church nursery contexts preferred
- Background check required
